1. Issues identified:

The following issues were highlighted.

Connectivity, transport and highways.

- Will Church Farm and others provide 3 buses per hour, daytime and 1 per hour evening, Sunday and bank holidays to Bletchley Close to Wavendon and Wavendon Gate.
- Three schools in Bedford have children a lighting the train at Bow Brickhill.
- Route 8 via Kingston needs to serve every 30 minutes.
- Through services to west of city please 7 days plus bank holidays.
- Semi fast rail to serve Bow Brickhill and Woburn Sands please - Anthony S Tull (Wavendon Gate resident).
- Will measures be put in place to stop Walton road rat run.
- Better, more frequent bus service to Central Milton Keynes.

Housing.

- Will people who currently live in the area and are currently overcrowded have priority to affordable housing within Church Farm.

Health and education.

- What schools are being built, any facilities for special needs
- Services need to be complete before houses are built as the pressure on schools and GP's in this area are already under too much pressure and oversubscribed
Schools and health centre need to be completed before houses built.
