

FURTHER NOTICE

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (ALL ROADS WITHIN MILTON KEYNES – HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2021

FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in relation to a temporary prohibition of vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along parts of roads within Milton Keynes whilst essential inspections, maintenance and repair works are carried out to the carriageway. The restrictions were brought into effect under the provisions of the above-named Order, which was made by the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes on 9th September 2021 under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as first notified on 2nd September 2021.

TAKE NOTICE that works are for **Lining Works**, it is necessary to introduce a road closure in order for the works to be carried out.

The following lengths of road will be closed on the following Dates and Times:

14th November 2022 – 19th November 2022

- **Newport Road, Woburn Sands** **(Between 9:00pm and 6:00am each night except weekends)**

From its Junction with Stockwell Lane to its junction with Summerline Drive

Whilst the following length of road is closed the alternative route will be via Newport Road, Groveway, Tongwell Street, Bletcham Way, Brickhill Street, Station Road, Woburn Sands Road, Bow Brickhill Road, the Leys, Hardwick Road, Station Road (and vice versa).

The closures and works will be carried out over 4 phases

Whilst the following length of road is closed the alternative route will be via Towcester Road, A5, Monks Way, Watling Street, Queen Eleanor Street (vice versa)

The above roads are scheduled to be closed **only** when maintenance or repair works are required and **only** when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

Access to affected properties will be granted where possible. All other provisions of the Order remain as previously notified on 2nd September 2021.
