One more death recorded over past 24 hours at Milton Keynes Hospital (417)

As at 16.00 today (Monday) the figure for MK is 648. Cases by MK area - last 7 days -Total number of people with at least one lab-confirmed positive COVID-19 test result in the most recent seven-day period. The rates per 100,000 resident population give a fairer comparison of the number of cases in each area but they do not take account of the different rates of testing or differences in the age and sex of the local populations. Data shown are cases by specimen date and because these are incomplete for the most recent dates, the period represented is the seven days ending 5 days before the date when the website was last updated.

- There were 49 new coronavirus cases and one virus-linked death announced in Milton Keynes today, according to the latest data.
- The latest update brings the total number of people tested positive in Milton Keynes since the start of the pandemic to 18,236 - of which 552 were in the past seven days.
- The 7-day case rate in Milton Keynes has fallen today from 216 cases per 100,000 people yesterday to 204.9 cases per 100,000 people today.

The national figure is up 13,013. Deaths within 28 days of positive test - daily deaths figure is – 1001 (Last 7 days – 5,516)

Confirmed Cases

A confirmed case is someone who has tested positive for coronavirus.

13,013 new people had a confirmed positive test result reported on 10 February 2021.

Between 4 February 2021 and 10 February 2021, 113,336 people had a confirmed positive test result. This shows a decrease of 27.7% compared to the previous 7 days.

Deaths

There were 1,001 deaths within 28 days of a positive test for coronavirus reported on 10 February 2021.

Between 4 February 2021 and 10 February 2021, there have been 5,516 deaths within 28 days of a positive coronavirus test. This shows a decrease of 25.9% compared to the previous 7 days.

Cases by area (last 7 days)

Total number of people with at least one positive COVID-19 test result (either lab-reported or lateral flow device) in the most recent seven-day period. The rates per 100,000 resident population give a fairer comparison of the number of cases in each area but they do not take account of the different rates of testing or differences in the age and sex of the local populations. 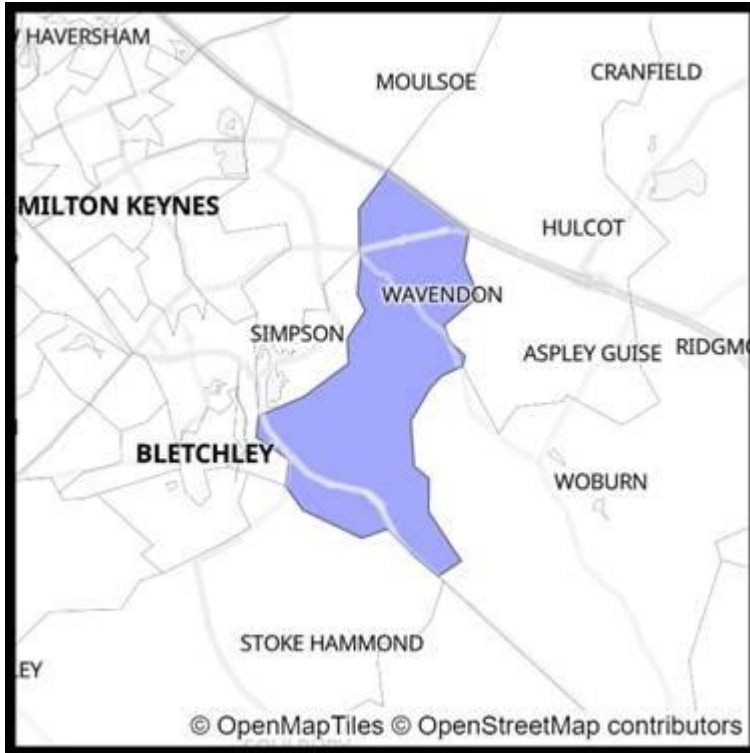
